Q 1	Query
	Is it possible to have a drawing regarding the steel structures of the aviary with the positions of stuffers, bracings, plates and bolts?
	Answer

Q2	Query
	Tender document refers to services engineer. Kindly indicate what qualification are required and if this can be the same key expert as the engineer requested as a separate key expert.
	Answer
	As Per Section 4, Article 9.5 iii of the tender documents, the Water Mains Pipe work "is to be tested for 4 hours at 1.5 times working pressure. A Services Engineer (warranted in terms of the Engineering Profession Act (Chapter 321)) shall be engaged by the Contractor at the Contractor's expense is to certify such a test."
Q3	Query
	As you are aware some requests are mostly custom fit for this project thus this situation would enable us to submit an offer in the best and proper professional method as possible, thus we are forwarding a request for a reasonable extension following receipt of all posted clarifications. Answer Regretfully, due to ERDF project timeframes it is not possible to give such an extension.









Q4	Query
	Kindy confirm if bidder can bid only for one tender out of three.
	Answer
	There aren't three tender, but one tender split into three lots. Biddes are free to tender for any combination of such lots. Indeed, as per Section 1, Article 3.1 of the tender document "Tenderers may submit a tender for one lot only OR several lots (one or more lots) OR all of the lots."
